

How to Complete an ACEP eCME Activity

- Follow the steps in the left navigation pane in order.
- Click “Refresh” each time you complete a step.
 - A yellow circle indicates “in progress” or that you’ve viewed a PDF or multimedia file.
 - A green circle indicates you’ve completed a confirmation or attestation.
 - A green checkmark indicates you’ve successfully completed a test.
- When you complete an activity, you’ll get an e-mail confirmation with instructions for creating your CME certificate.

Of note:

- The Confirmation Statement is your attestation that you’ve read the Instructions to Learners.
- You’ll take a pretest only once for each activity. You don’t have to pass it.
- A course or activity can be a PDF, a slide presentation with audio, a video, or some other format.
- To get CME credit, you have to get a passing score on the post-test. You can take it as many times as you need to.
- You’ll also need to do a short evaluation and attest that you completed the activity according to “Method of Participation.”

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Method of Participation
